

Required Supplies for the Laura Heine Collage Quilt Class Guild Workshop

Instructor: Linda Lambert

Skills Level: Beginner--no sewing experience is needed for this class.

Class Description: You will learn Laura Heine's process of collage quilting. While creating your design you will look at value, hues, and motifs to layer fabric while creating your collage quilt. We will use a kit for this class and you may use your scrap stash for future designs. Learn Laura Heine's techniques to successfully create, secure, and quilt your work of art!

Expectation: You will learn the process of Laura Heine Collage Quilting. You should be able to have your collage completed by the end of class. Suggestions on quilting and finishing your quilt will be shared in this class.

Supply List:

- Laura Heine Pattern
 - Teeny Tiny Pattern #5 Sewing Machine, Pin Cushion, Dress Form
 - Special Workshop Price of \$20, purchased through Linda.
 - Please let me know # of patterns 2 weeks prior to the workshop.
- All other supplies may be purchased from Quilter's Quest
- 3-5 yards of Steam a Seam 2 (no substitutes), 12" or 24" will be fine
 - You can purchase this at your local quilt shop. I will have Steam a Seam 2 on hand also.
 - 3-5 yards is for a 19x23 quilt. If your quilt is larger, you will need more.
- Pattern Ease 9x23 inches
- Karen K. Buckley scissors
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Applique mat, 17" x 24" (We build our quilt from the applique mat)
 - You must have these to create!
 - Another name for an applique mat is a fusing mat. This may come with a pressing sheet (packaged together)
- Pressing sheet
- Iron – Optional (The guild will have some ironing stations set up)
- Fabric!
 - You may bring some of your own fabric to personalize your collage.
 - To teach the process of collage quilting within our time frame, we will use a kit to help you get started.
 - Kits will be available from Quilter's Quest (Sometime in mid to late May)
- You will NOT need your sewing machine for this class.
